What's new for 2018?



- **A team approach** - Attendees are asked to register in teams of 2-4 people. Teams could include a combination of CSP staff, Case Managers, Families, Self-Advocates, Vocational Rehabilitation, Long Term Services, Teachers, etc. Teams should include **PCT Champions** - people who are using the PCT in their life/work to help people have better lives. **Get a team together and come with ideas of a goals you'd like to accomplish together!**
- **Learning, Coaching & Sharing** - Teams will be developing a vision, goals, and an action plan to keep PCT moving forward in your life, work, and/or organization through large and small groups.
- **PCT Basics & Beyond & LifeCourse Framework** - Learning and coaching sessions will focus on person-centered thinking skills. Participants will gain a deeper understanding of a person-centered philosophy, person-centered thinking skills and the ways to apply them. Tools from Charting the LifeCourse will be used to assist in developing your team plan.
