

Public Comment Notice

The Assistive Daily Living Services (ADLS) Waiver Amendment is available for public comment for 30 days from February 8, 2016 to March 9, 2016.

What is the ADLS Waiver Amendment?

The ADLS waiver is a Home and Community Based Services Medicaid waiver for people who have quadriplegia living in South Dakota, that allows services to be provided at home and in the community. This amendment will impact individuals who are currently receiving services on the waiver, as well as anyone interested in receiving services through the waiver in the future. The Department intends to make this amendment effective July 1, 2016.
